CAMPFIRE PROTOCOL

- 1. NO SINGING, CHANTS, OR YELLS**
- 2. CAMPFIRE SHOULD BE WITH PATROL ONLY**
- 3. NO SHARING OF FOOD – FOOD MAY BE PRE-PORTIONED INTO INDIVIDUAL BAGS
ie: A S'MORES KIT.**
- 4. MAINTAIN PHYSICAL DISTANCING**
- 5. BRING YOUR OWN CHAIR, ROASTING STICKS
WATER BOTTLE & SNACKS**
- 6. TAKE ALL GARBAGE AND PERSONAL GEAR WITH YOU WHEN YOU LEAVE**
- 7. FOLLOW MEETING PROTOCOL**

**FOLLOW MEETING
PROTOCOL**

MEETING REQUIREMENTS

BRING YOUR OWN CAMP CHAIR, SNACKS, BUG REPELLENT, SUNSCREEN, AND WATER AND TAKE IT WITH YOU WHEN YOU LEAVE (IF REQUIRED FOR THE MEETING/ACTIVITY)

GROUPS REQUIRE A SET OF CONTACT TRACING FORMS FOR EACH IN PERSON MEETING/ACTIVITY TO BE RETAINED IN A BINDER FOR FOUR WEEKS

REGISTRATION/MEDICAL FORM FOR EACH PARTICIPANT (YOUTH & ADULT) NEED TO BE BROUGHT TO EVERY MEETING/ACTIVITY – YOU MAY NEED ADDITIONAL CONTACT INFORMATION IF SOMEONE BECOMES ILL.

**HAND SANITIZER MUST BE PROVIDED (minimum 60% alcohol)
ALL PARTICIPANTS MUST BRING HAND SANITIZER, BRING AND WEAR A MASK FOR SITUATIONS WHERE PHYSICAL DISTANCING IS DIFFICULT**

CRAFT SUPPLIES/MEETING SUPPLIES SHOULD BE PROVIDED IN INDIVIDUAL BAGS THAT ARE CLEARLY LABELLED, PREPARE THESE AT LEAST 48 HOURS AHEAD OF THE MEETING. CHOOSE ACTIVITIES THAT DO NOT REQUIRE HANDS-ON ASSISTANCE.

GROUPS REQUIRE A SET OF SCREENING QUESTIONS. SUGGEST: LAMINATING ONE COLOUR SET TO BE USED AND PLACE IN FRONT POCKET OF CONTACT TRACING BINDER

CONSULT MUNICIPAL/PROVINCIAL/FEDERAL HEALTH GUIDELINES FOR ADDITIONAL PROTOCOLS THAT MAY BE REQUIRED.

Definition of Vulnerable Persons

1. Over 65 years of age **WITH:**
2. Risk due to underlying health conditions, such as: Heart Disease, Hypertension, Diabetes, Chronic Respiratory Diseases, Cancer.
3. Risk due to a Compromised Immune System, ie: undergoing chemotherapy.
4. Caregiver to other vulnerable people.

Use your best judgement. Participate if you feel you can safely do so. Do not feel you are required to attend any meeting or activity that you are not comfortable with. Before making a decision, you may contact the Commissioner. 519-572-7024

Vulnerable members who do not feel they can safely participate are encouraged to participate using alternative methods whenever possible. (ZOOM, Microsoft Teams, Google Meet, Phone) Ask Kim for assistance with ZOOM if you would like to use it.
